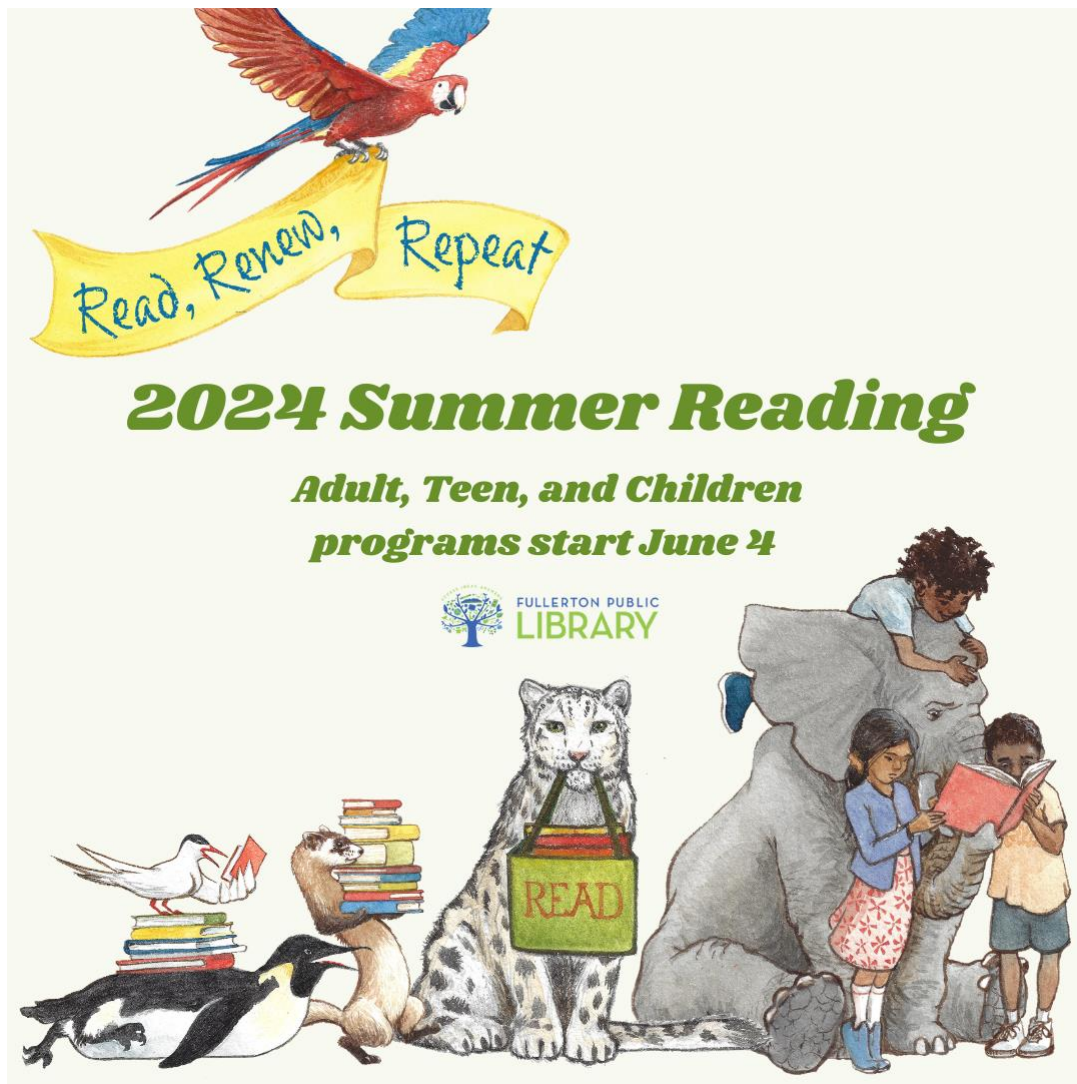

Summer Reading Kickoff Annie Banannie, Balloon Artist

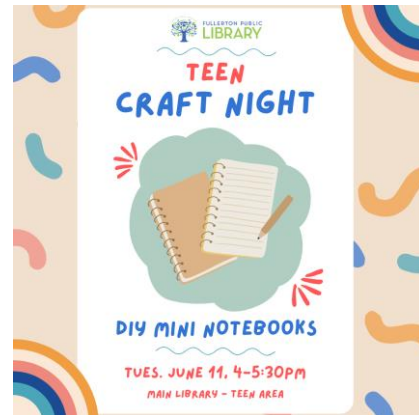
Tuesday, June 11, 2:00pm

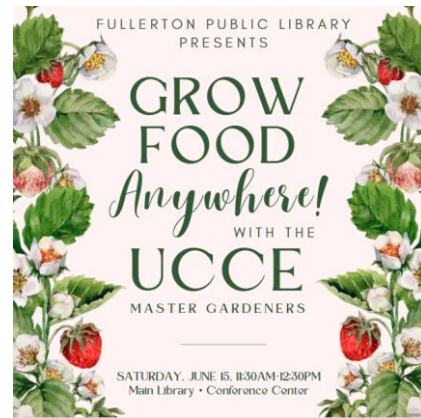

Join Alzheimer's Orange County to learn about common red flags, how to approach difficult conversations, and find the best plan for optimal well-being! Bring your questions!

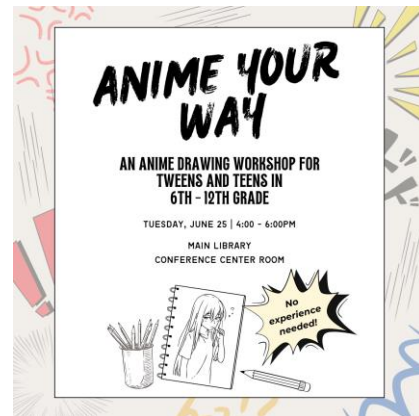
