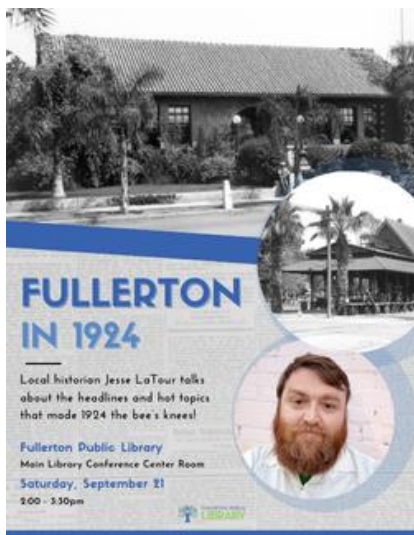

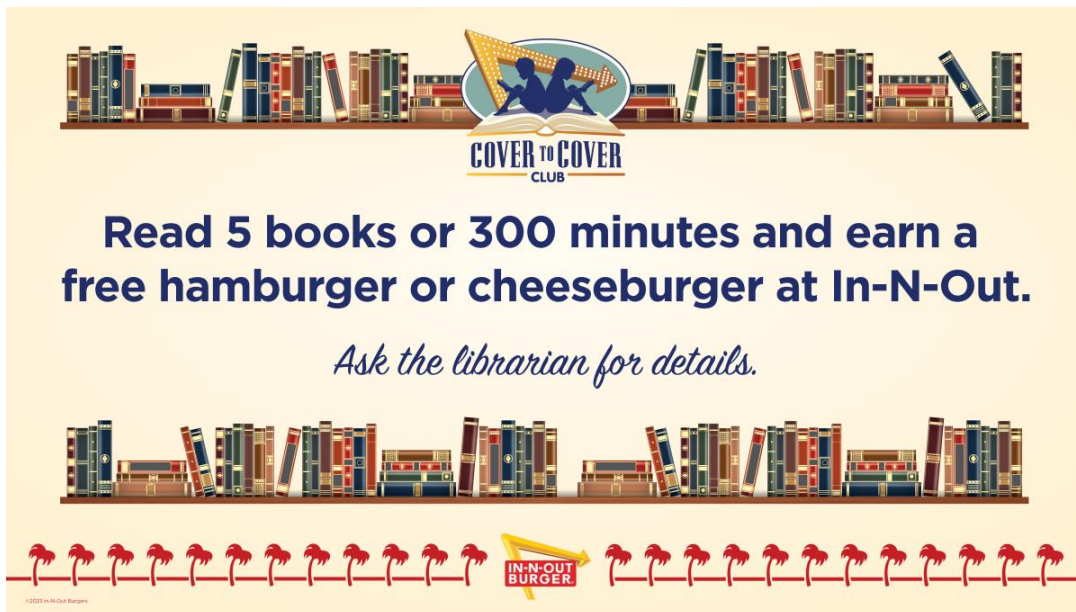
Check Out Our Expanding Collection!

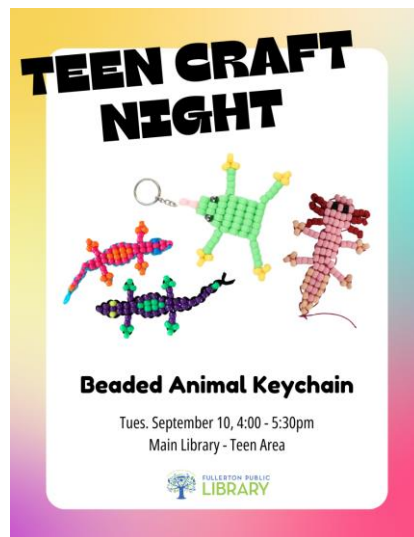
Teen Craft Night

Kids and Families Celebrate the End of Summer Reading with a Party!

Kids and families celebrated the end of the Summer Reading Club at the Main Library on Thursday August 1, with a congratulatory extravaganza featuring snacks, movies, crafts, and fun. Children also enjoyed face painting by our intrepid staff and two kinds of cake! 215 kids and grownups

attended, plus a crew of 12 teen volunteers to help pull it off! The Children's Summer Reading program officially ended August 3. This year, 880 children signed up for the program. A whopping 70% of participants logged enough reading minutes to earn at least one prize. 38.5% of participants, or 339 children, completed all seven prize levels! That's A LOT of reading minutes, and a lot of lifelong reading and learning development! Great job kids and parents!



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
