


Early Literacy Program Update: Our Spring **Stay & Play** and **Preschool Storytime** sessions at Hunt Branch Library **end May 7 and 8!**

Fashionable Teens Score Big at Clothing Swap!

On Saturday, April 26, the library teamed up with Sunny Hills High School's Thrifting Club to host our third clothing swap event for teens at the Main Library! A clothing swap is a type of flea market or swap meet where participants exchange their valued but no longer used clothing for new items they will use. Teens in 7th-12th grade were able to bring their gently worn, clean clothing items to swap for new items from other teens to revamp their wardrobes. Cabinet members from the Thrifting Club were excited to help by designing the flyer, decorating the space, and organizing clothing items.
