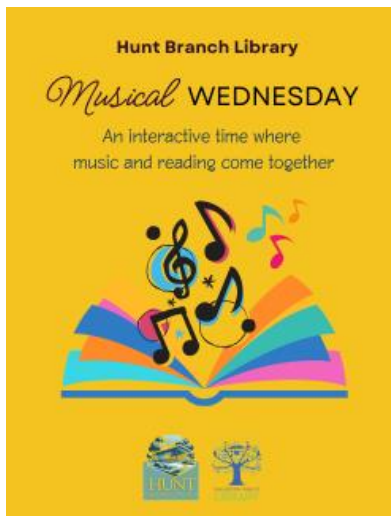


Hunt Branch Family Storytime

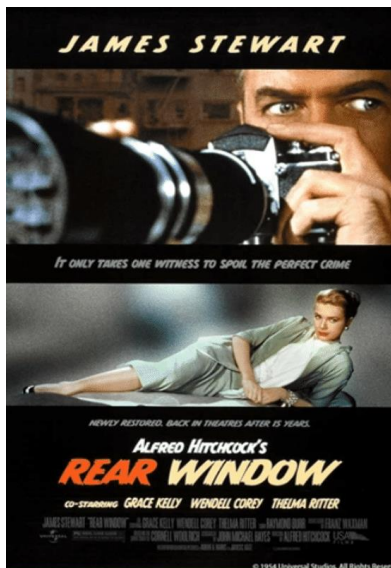
Picnic Storytime

Brettso the Great Amazes the Library!

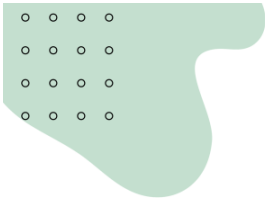
