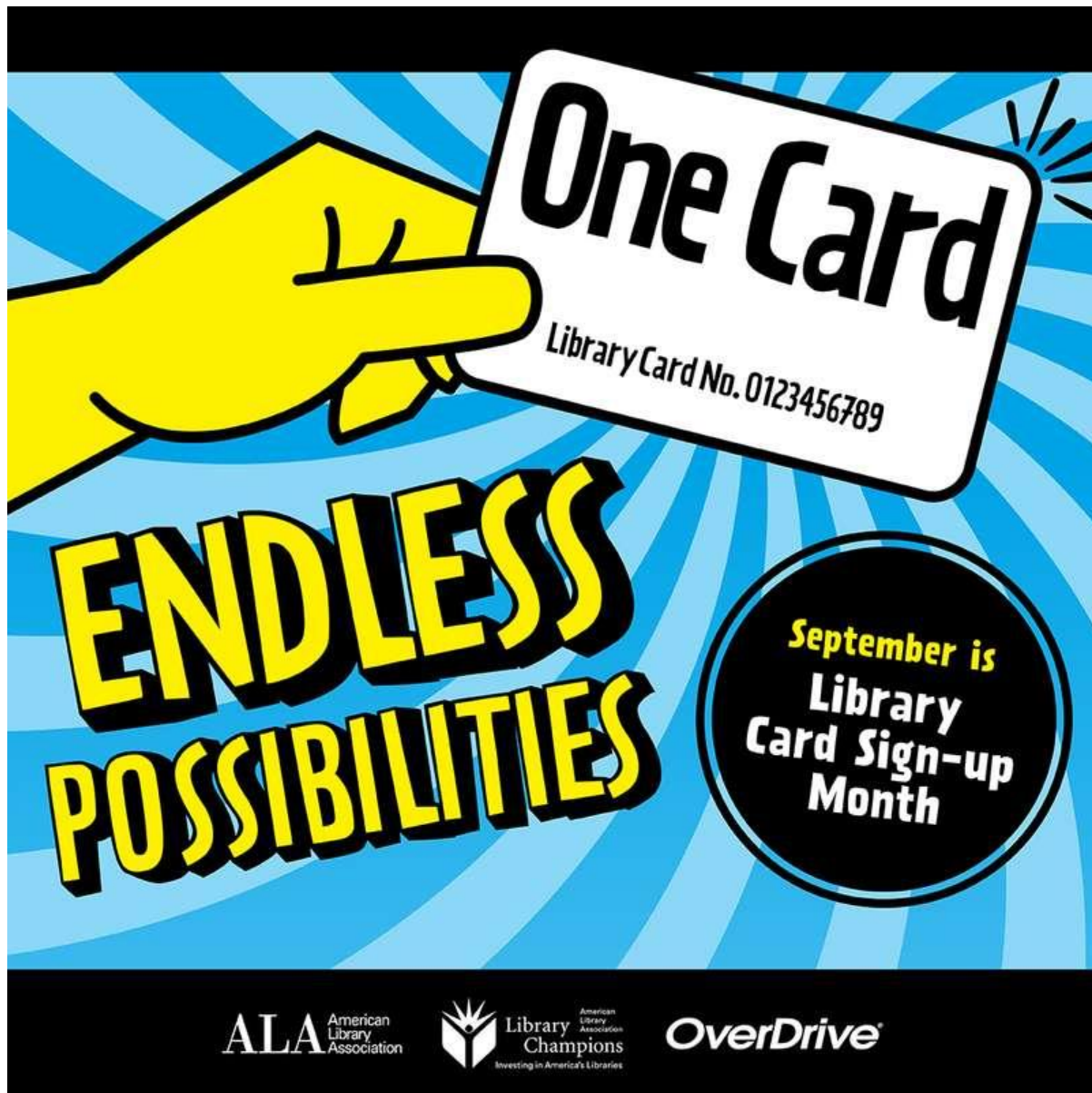

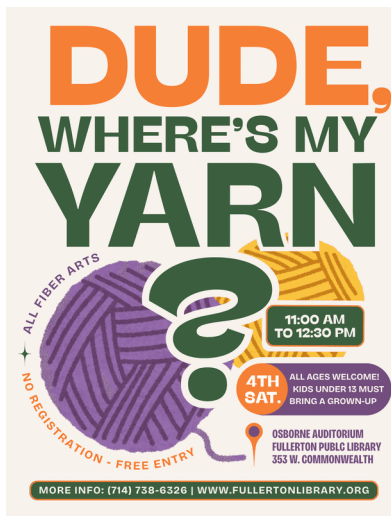

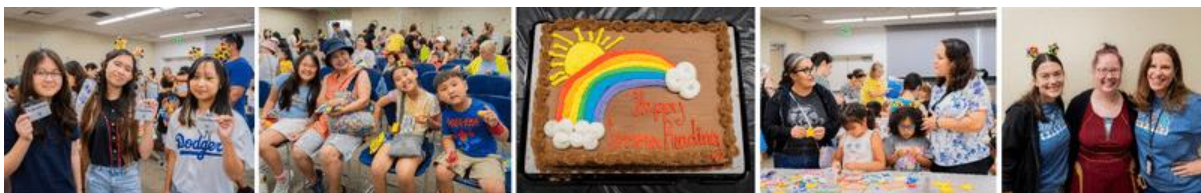

Summer Reading Wrap Up!

The 2025 Kids' Summer Reading Club was a rousing success with participants racking up an impressive 649,926 minutes of reading from June 3 to August 2. A

total of 895 children registered for the online reading incentive program through the READsquared app. Reader engagement was high with 69% of registrants earning at least one prize level. 356 (39%) of our readers achieved all 7 prize levels! We also had 521 kids attend our three special summer reading events at the Main Library, including Brettso the Great and our End of Summer Celebration.

The library hosts summer reading programs for teens and adults, which continues through September 20, as well. We give many thanks to our fabulous program sponsors who make it all possible: the Friends of the Fullerton Public Library, the Assistance League of Fullerton, Bruster's Ice Cream, Lazy Dog Café, the Old Spaghetti Factory, Patty's Cakes and Desserts, Raising Cane's Chicken Fingers, Two Saucy Broads, Yogurtland, and Zombee Donuts. 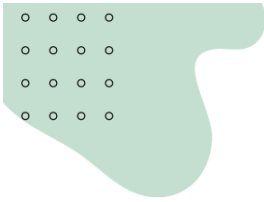
